**BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE PERRY COUNTY COMMISSION MET** in its regular session on Tuesday, March 24, 2020 at 6:00 P.M. at the Albert Turner, Sr. Courthouse Annex in the commission courtroom. Invocation by Cedric Hudson. Roll call was called to establish a quorum. District #1: Present; District #2: Absent; District #3: Present; District #4: Present; District #5: Present.

**Motion** by Commissioner Eaton and seconded by Commissioner Harrison to adopt the agenda with the amendment to add Sheriff Jones. **Motion** carried unanimously.

**Motion** by Commissioner Turner and seconded by Commissioner Eaton to adopt the minutes from March 10, 2020 and emergency Commission Meeting minutes from March 18<sup>th</sup> and March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2020. **Motion** carried.

**ITEM #15: Sheriff Jones**

Sheriff Jones presented quotes for hot water repair.

**Motion** by Albert Turner and seconded by Benjamin Eaton to replace the hot water heaters with tank less water heaters at the jail. **Motion** carried.

**Motion** by Albert Turner and seconded by Benjamin Eaton to accept the bid with the most comparable gallons per minute on the tank less water heaters and also authorize the sheriff to accept the lowest bid. **Motion** carried.

**Health Coordinator**

Discussed conference call with Terri Sewell related to covid-19 issues.

Inform that the Cahaba Medical is testing anyone who exhibits symptoms of covid-19

**Motion** by Albert Turner and seconded by Brett Harrison to change the Corona virus policy to have a temperature of 100.4 instead of 99.5 or follow the CDC guidelines if that changes. **Motion** carried.

**Engineer/EMA Report:**

**Motion** by Albert Turner and seconded by Benjamin Eaton to adopt the resolution for the County state of emergency act with city of Uniontown and make it retroactive until March 18, 2020. **Motion** carried.

**Motion** by Brett Harrison and seconded by Albert Turner for the 1989 3qtr Chevy truck with travel trailer make salvage. **Motion** carried.

**Motion** by Albert Turner and seconded by Benjamin Eaton to accept resignation/retirement of Albert Paige as of April 1st 2020. **Motion** carried.

**Clerk Report:**

**Motion** by Albert Turner and seconded by Benjamin Eaton to pay their portion of the ambulance bill by deducting from the garage payment from the county and to send an MOU to reflect this decision. **Motion** carried.

**Motion** by Albert Turner and seconded by Benjamin Eaton to use Servpro for \$1,896 for 3 weeks for a total of \$5,688. **Motion** carried.

**Motion** by Albert Turner and seconded by Benjamin Eaton to accept the USDA loan for \$840,000 and that the loan shall be repaid with our Federal Exchange and Rebuild Alabama funds and to place these funds in a separate interest bearing account and amend application to include County Road 65. **Motion** carried. Nea; Brett Harrison.

**Secondary motion** by Brett Harrison to apply for USDA funds and use funds for roads that was in the grant. **Motion died for lack of a second.**
